COMMEMORATING 50 YEARS OF OCCUPATION

On **Monday June 5, 2017**, the Arab Educational Institute will organize day-long events along the Wall in Bethlehem to commemorate 50 years of occupation.

The venue will be near the Sumud Story House in north-Bethlehem, close to the French and Chinese restaurants there.

PROGRAM

14:30 - 16:00

BIRDS OF PALESTINE – Children program, with arts, singing, clown and drama in front of the Wall – Children showing their playfulness and life in front of the wall. With 'Inad Theatre (Beit Jala): "What after 50 years of occupation?"

16:00 - 18:00

OCCUPATION, ARTS AND SUMUD - Opening of 50 new Wall posters which communicate 50 aspects of occupation as well as people's *sumud* or steadfastness. The posters in the area will tell stories of *sumud* and expose the occupation. Participants will take a walk along the Wall.

IMAGINE TO BE BORN IN BETHLEHEM - Palestinian women will project photos on the Wall about their daily life under occupation (Agentur Schwimmer photo project).

OCCUPATION AND FREEDOM – 18 international artists submit arts works on the themes of occupation and freedom. A Dutch artist will give an explanation of her work. The works will be shown throughout the day near the Wall.

BETHLEHEM SUMUD CHOIR - Choir performances and drama presentations to commemorate 50 years of occupation and express Palestinian unity.

PALESTINIAN SINGER/MUSICIAN – George Thalgieh (not yet confirmed)

SAWA, a Palestinian youth music group, performs songs on *sumud* and youth rights.

MOSLEM-CHRISTIAN LIVING TOGETHER - Drama performance and presentations given by Palestinian youth bring out the strength of Palestinian Moslem-Christian living together in the face of occupation and restrictions on the freedom of movement.

MOSLEM-CHRISTIAN LIVING TOGETHER – A Ramadan Iftar with performances and choir singing. (needs reservation)
